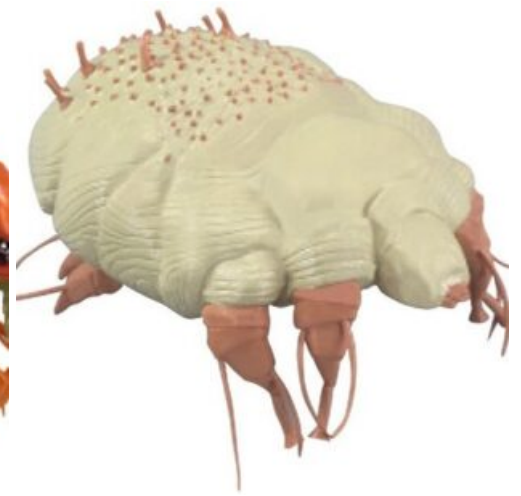

The flea is a tiny wingless insect with a hard and laterally flat body designed to easily navigate through pet hair, legs designed for jumping great distances, and mouthparts designed to suck blood. This external parasite feeds upon the blood of a host, usually a mammal. There are several species of flea, but the one that most commonly affects dogs, cats and other house pets in North America is the cat flea, also known as *Ctenocephalides felis*. This flea prefers cats, dogs, rabbits and similar small mammals.

Ticks are parasitic arthropods that live on the blood of their hosts. On its head, the tick clings on an its mouthparts into the skin, to blood meal. Once locked in place, it will not detach until its meal is complete. It may continue to feed for several days, depending on the type of tick. Dog ticks often attach the crevices and/or areas with less typically in and around the ear where the inside of the leg is between the toes, and within 1
